Vocations Sunday - Save the Date

This year Archbishop's Examining Chaplains and the Diocesan Vocations Advocate are encouraging all worshipping communities to put aside one day on which to reflect particularly on the theme of calling and vocation. This may have a focus on discerning a call to ordained ministry – but is a chance also to reflect on the wider Christian vocation to live out our Baptismal calling.

In the morning, the Candidates in Formation, as well as a selection of clergy from Wollaston Theological College and the Examining Chaplains, are making themselves available to preach – so invitations are welcomed. Please email pking@perth.anglican.org to express willingness to vacate your pulpit, and we shall despatch preachers accordingly! This is particularly aimed at those parishes not already hosting a Candidate in Formation.

In the evening, at 5pm, the Cathedral Church of St George is hosting a service of Choral Evensong on the theme, at which the Vocations Advocate shall preach. All are welcome and indeed encouraged to attend – to celebrate and pray for the flourishing of vocations in this diocese, gathering together to mark the end of a weekend of dispersed activities.

Discernment to the Ordained Ministry:

In every generation the Church looks for those for whom Christ's insistent call 'disturbs their settled lives'. On behalf of the Church, the Archbishop's Examining Chaplains discern whether that call might be to ordained ministry.

Bicentenary Celebration at St Matthew’s Anglican Church, Windsor NSW

In October 2017, St Matthews Anglican Church Windsor will be celebrating the bicentenary of the laying of the foundation stone by Governor Lachlan Macquarie on 11 October 1817, making St Matthew’s the oldest Anglican church, by foundation stone, in Australia. The design is by convict architect Francis Greenway.

St Matthew’s and its associated graveyard are historically significant to the state of NSW and to the Hawkesbury area. The church has been the centre of spiritual life in the district since it was consecrated by the Reverend Samuel Marsden on 18 December 1822, with many families marking marriages, baptisms and deaths over several generations.

The Big Birthday Bash is being held in McQuade park Windsor with a concert featuring special guest Colin Buchanan.
