In this three-day course, participants are immersed in Godly Play practice, and learn and tell a story for supportive feedback.

In this time two accredited trainers will work with the group to provide information and experience of the three genres of stories in Godly Play, the role of the storyteller, the role of the doorperson, the Godly Play space, materials, response time, spirituality of the child, forming and maintaining a respectful story circle community, the history and practice of Godly Play and much more. Aliens and Strangers

'I expect to die in bed, my successor will die in prison, and his successor will die a martyr in the public square.' Some have deemed this well-known quote from Francis Cardinal George a little alarmist, and perhaps it is. There is, however, no avoiding the fact that as our culture continues to secularise, the church is increasingly being pushed further to the margins. We can't rely upon the cultural capital that we have traded on in the past; in some cases, we can't even rely upon a general feeling of goodwill. Our identity as aliens and strangers in the world is something we can only expect to feel more keenly.

And so the question is: how will we inhabit that space faithfully? How will we continue to bear costly witness from the margins? How will we maintain our strange identity as citizens of another Country, while speaking of that Country to neighbours who have never heard of it, or who are disinterested in it, or who despise it, and yet who continue to feel, as Chesterton put it, 'homesick while at home'?

Fortunately, our time is not the first in which the Church has had to engage with these questions. Indeed, it has been engaging with them from its beginning. Come to clergy school to engage scripture and the tradition, and consider what it means for us to be aliens and strangers in 21st century Australia.

Access to Parish Registers

In order to come in line with the Department of Births, Death and Marriages and the State Library the confidential access time frames for all registers in the Diocese are being extended.

The following table sets out when access may be granted to entries in the different types of registers. The closed period is for access by the public, exceptions to that timeframe are detailed in each case:

- Baptism Register- Closed for 100 years, but open to the individuals who were baptised or their parents listed in the register entry, upon application and proof of identity

- Marriage Register- Closed for 75 years, but open to the two individuals whom the entry concerns, upon application and proof of identity
 - Burial Register - Closed for 30 years
- If your collection has been transferred to the Diocesan Archives, please ask the person enquiring to contact the Archives.

If your registers are still located within your parish, the application form and a copy of the identification must be sighted and approved before access is granted and a certificate created for the enquirer.
