NOTE TO PARISHES ON REFERRING A HOMELESS PERSON

Parishes often encounter people struggling with homelessness, sleeping rough with no income, no fixed address, no identification documents and no Centrelink help. They might also have limited English skills.

Day centres can be a useful service for the homeless, where staff will accommodate and care for them in the short term, link them to available long term accommodation and break through the issues of no income by connecting to Centrelink after organising necessary documents.

CHURCHSAFE / CHILD PROTECTION TRAINING

In keeping with the guidelines of the Safe Ministry to Children Canon (adopted at Synod 2017), licensing and diocesan policy requirements and our commitment to safe ministry in the diocese, it is a requirement that those who have not attended Churchsafe since September 2015, **must do so before 31 December.**

While it is acknowledged by the Diocese that there are several options of child protection and protective behaviours training available in the community, it is a requirement of the General Synod office that all Churchworkers attend training that is accredited by and, specific to the Anglican church.

For General Synod audit requirements, catering and seating arrangements, registrations are compulsory. Go to www.perth.anglican.org/events/
