Policy Updates

At the August Perth Diocesan Trustees (PDT) meeting, the PDT approved the adoption of the Whistle Blower Policy. This policy has been developed primarily for the use by direct employees of the PDT, though it may be of use in other ministry contexts and does not override the use of the Professional Standards Statute. For employees located at Church House, Swan Valley Adventure Centre and at Wollaston this may be a helpful policy to help staff raise concerns in their workplace that they feel need the attention of people who are not their direct manager.
