There is plenty of parking available in the area around the College Chapel, and the nearest train station is Bull Creek. To keep the catering to a minimum, knitters are asked to bring their own lunch, however tea, coffee and soft drinks will be provided by members of Bull Creek-Leeming parish.

Past experience has shown that knitted blankets can prove a problem for those who are homeless and living on the streets. They are too difficult to care for and are often stolen. When they become dirty and/or wet they are simply abandoned. Granny squares or strips in 8-ply wool will still be needed and these will be joined to make blankets, as usual. These blankets will now, however, be distributed through various city agencies and refuges. A greater need is for Beanies and Scarves.

### LOTTERYWEST GRANTS UPDATE

LotteryWest have ceased defining funding rounds for their grants streams, all grant funding streams are now scheduled to open at the end of March and remain open all year.

In terms of '**Heritage Funding**' LotteryWest still offer funding for natural and built heritage, as well as documentation (research, displays, signage, conservation or interpretation plans etc.) and community histories (recording/sharing of experiences of a place, person, organisation etc.) however, LotteryWest are changing their focus to ensure there is a '**community benefit**' aspect to each project and do not encourage '**heritage for heritage sake**' projects moving forward unless a strong community benefit can be demonstrated.

This is a significant change and will impact how parishes prepare grant applications.

#### **The Reverend Terry McAuliffe**

It has been in the public domain that certain proceedings were commenced by The Reverend Terry McAuliffe against the Archbishop. Those proceedings were settled at mediation on 13 November 2014. It has been agreed that the following statement would be published but otherwise the terms of settlement are confidential:

*Due to the sincere efforts of both parties, the Archbishop of Perth and the Reverend Terry McAuliffe has reached a resolution of matters concerning the office of the Archdeacon of Stirling.*

*In retrospect, the events in 2011 were precipitated by a misunderstanding between them which they both regret.*

*The Archbishop wishes to make clear that there was no serious wrongdoing or misconduct in the performance by the Reverend McAuliffe of his responsibilities as Archdeacon. As he did in 2011, the Archbishop gives thanks for the ministry of the Venerable Terry McAuliffe as Archdeacon of Stirling and before that as Archdeacon of Forrest (Southern Region).*
