THE WOLLASTON CERTIFICATE IN THEOLOGY

In term three, the Wollaston Certificate offers teaching from experts and highly credentialed academics in Christian Doctrine and Anglican Studies.

Core unit - Introduction to Christian Doctrine

This is a core unit in the Wollaston Certificate, which can be completed either through attendance at lectures, or externally online. This unit introduces some of the major themes and disciplines of Christian theology through a focus on Jesus Christ. It is designed to assist students to consider theological questions through the lens of Christology.

Option 1 - In person seminars. The Reverend Dr Gregory Seach, Warden of Wollaston College, presents an introduction to Christian theology in eight seminars.

Elective unit - Anglican Studies

This unit explores the development of Anglican faith and life from Christian origins in Britain/England to the present world-wide Communion. Anglicanism in the Australian context will also be studied, with a focus on Anglican understandings of education.

External study - This unit is being taught as intensive in Cobram, Victoria by The Reverend Dr Seach, from 31 August - 2 September. All lectures will be recorded and available to enrolled students based in the Diocese of Perth online.

HERITAGE GRANTS PROGRAMME 2018/2019

The State Heritage Council has informed the diocese that the [Heritage Grants Programme](#) is now open for applications for the 2018/19 year. Please note that applications must be in by noon on Wednesday 8 August 2018. Applications lodged after this date will not be accepted.

This year, a total of \$1.222 million is being offered to private owners of State Registered heritage places for conservation works and conservation related documentation. Funding is offered on a dollar for dollar basis, with the maximum grant set at \$100,000. If you are interested in the programme and require an application form, please contact The Heritage Council on 6552 4117. The application form is not available online.

Please note that the restriction on applications from new owners remains in place. Exceptions can be considered, so please contact the Heritage Council if this affects you.

As part of this initiative, the Heritage Council is operating a free submission review service to all applicants to assist the application to be completed to the best of its ability and hopefully increase the chances of it being successful. Should you wish to take advantage of this free service, all draft applications would need to be submitted by 31 July 2018.



Please note that all applications to the Heritage Council **must be submitted by the diocese as the legal landowner** however the diocese would be happy to assist parishes with any queries.

CHURCHSAFE / CHILD PROTECTION TRAINING

In keeping with the guidelines of the Safe Ministry to Children Canon (adopted at Synod 2017), licensing and diocesan policy requirements and our commitment to safe ministry in the diocese, it is a requirement that those who have not attended Churchsafe since September 2015, **must do so before 31 December**.

While it is acknowledged by the diocese that there are several options of child protection and protective behaviours training available in the community, it is a requirement of the General Synod office that all church workers attend training that is accredited by and, specific to the Anglican Church.

For General Synod audit requirements, catering and seating arrangements, registrations are compulsory.
