Vision and Ethos - We seek to follow Jesus, love Him, become like Him and see his Kingdom grow.

Services - Two Sunday services are held each week, with an established practice of congregational leadership and participation. There is an openness to and experience of, different styles of worship and music. Services are conducted periodically at two other centres.

Outreach - A weekly Emergency Food Relief program, a variety of church related groups, special event services, ALPHA and kids program are run from the parish centre. The church aims to model the life of the early church as in the book of Acts – being welcoming to all.

Physical Resources - Centrally located in a recognized growth node within the Perth Metropolitan area, the Church of the Ascension is a large, well-kept building with capacity for development. A generous parish hall is located across the street and a large rectory is available in a nearby suburb. Church properties provide rental income which is used to enable ministry.

requirements and our commitment to safe ministry in the diocese, it is a requirement that those who have not attended Churchsafe since September 2015, **must do so before 31 December**.

While it is acknowledged by the diocese that there are several options of child protection and protective behaviours training available in the community, it is a requirement of the General Synod office that all church workers attend training that is accredited by and, specific to the Anglican Church.
